Watercolours by Philippa Blair, Robyn Kahukiwi, Keith Patterson, Geoff Thornley, Roy Good, and others are also included in this eclectic exhibition.

**Auckland Art Fair** 7 - 11th August 2013

As the daffodils came out so did around 40 Galleries from Australasia and around 8000 visitors to this year's Auckland Art Fair. Sunday was a bit miserable but visitor's trekked through all day. We featured works by Alexander Bartleet, Mark Wooller, Fatu Feu'u, Robyn Kahukiwi, Amy Melchior, Justin Summerton, Chris Pole, Philippa Blair and Nick Wall. At the fair we changed the walls every day and received positive comments all week, particularly from visitors who had purchased a 4 day pass. Alexander Bartleet's large new Tondo with accompanying small assemblages drew great interest in particular as did new works from other feature artists. The large Robyn Kahukiwi "Ko Te Kuia Me Te Kereru" sold on the opening night to expats in Australia and Alex Bartleet sold several of his smaller works. Mark Wooller's new works sold well and were much admired by those who had not seen his "bushscape" series before.
